The Stan and Maureen Duke Gold Coast Art Prize is an acquisitive art award and exhibition, open to all forms of art media except photography. Photographic based artists are encouraged to enter our annual Josephine Ulrick and Win Schubert Photography Award.

This Prize is managed by Gold Coast City Art Gallery and began its life in 1968 with the inaugural Gold Coast Art Prize. The prize now enters a new era with the support of the Stan and Maureen Duke Foundation. Stan and Maureen Duke moved to Mackay in 1964 where Stan set up a practice as a General Surgeon and Urologist and Maureen as a General Physician with a special interest in Pediatrics. They were the first specialists in their fields to practice full time in Mackay and made a great contribution to the community. Maureen died of breast cancer in 1986, aged 51. Stan Duke has now retired on the Gold Coast and established the Foundation to provide continuing support for the community.

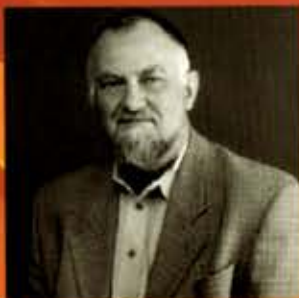

This year marks a new era in the history of the prize with the support of the Stan and Maureen Duke Foundation. For the first time we are able to offer a cash prize of \$10,000 for the winner while maintaining our acquisition purse of \$20,000. We trust that this incentive is what led to over 400 artists entering the Prize. Our sincere thanks to Stan Duke for creating the Foundation and offering to begin what will hopefully become a long and fruitful relationship. The future outlook for the event is very bright.

We also thank our esteemed judge Anthony Bond OAM who had the arduous task of selecting the 67 finalists listed here for exhibition. He will also select the winner and advise on acquisitions. We are truly grateful to Tony for the enormous amount of time and effort he has given the task and for his professional and insightful approach.

We are also grateful to the Bodies Corporate of Ania Broadbeach for continuing the Living Art Award. One artist from this year's exhibition will be selected to have their work reproduced on a 6 x 7 metre billboard gracing the side of the Ania building. Robert Boynes was selected from the 2006 exhibition and his work Red Waterfall has recently been unveiled on the lively café precinct.

Our sincere thanks go to all of the artists who entered the Prize and in particular the finalists who have made work available for us to present such a diverse and engaging exhibition of contemporary Australian art.
