

# Logan art winners

**A GOLD Coast artist has received \$5000 in prizemoney as the winner of this year's Logan Art Award.**

Joe Furlonger, 38, won the award from a record entry of 477 artistic pieces for his oil on canvas work titled *Village In Dorset*.

Entries were received for four categories, with the winner of each section receiving \$500 in prizemoney from the Council and a commemorative trophy.

Winner of Category 1, for Paintings, was Sebastian Di Mauro, of Kelvin Grove, for his three-piece painting *Void Remembrance*.

Helene Grove, of Bundaberg, was named the winner of Category 2, Watercolour Gouache, for her work

*Landscape with Snake Bird*.

The ink drawing, called *Girl on a Wall*, by Genny Haasz, took the honours for Category Three — Other Works On Paper.

And a tin sculpture, titled *They Sometimes Walk and Talk Like That* by Minuella Chapman won the sculptures category.

A final winner in the Awards will be determined by Super South residents who view the Exhibition, which ends on Sunday, October 14, at the Kingston Butter Factory Community Arts Centre.

The exhibit judged most popular will be awarded \$500 prizemoney and viewers can purchase most of the art works on display.
